School dinners

School dinners will be provided in the dinner hall. Dinners cost £2.60 per meal and all meals should be paid for using our cashless payment system Parent Pay. Any new parents will receive information on registering for Parent Pay in the first few days back to school.

If you think you may be entitled to free school meals (FSM), please register with the Education Authority and apply at the link below. Please note that parents whose child/children were in receipt of FSM during the 2022/23 school year also need to apply for these children (as well as any additional children) for the 2023/24 school year. Any meals taken before confirmation of entitlement to FSM will be subject to a charge of £2.60 per meal. You can apply for FSMs and the Education Authority's uniform grant at the link below:

Breakfast club and After Schools Clubs

Due to staff training After Schools Clubs for all pupils will recommence on Tuesday 12th September. They will run Monday- Thursday at a cost of £2 per day. From Tuesday, 12th September, all children using the afterschool club, including those using the bus service will be charged £2 per day.
