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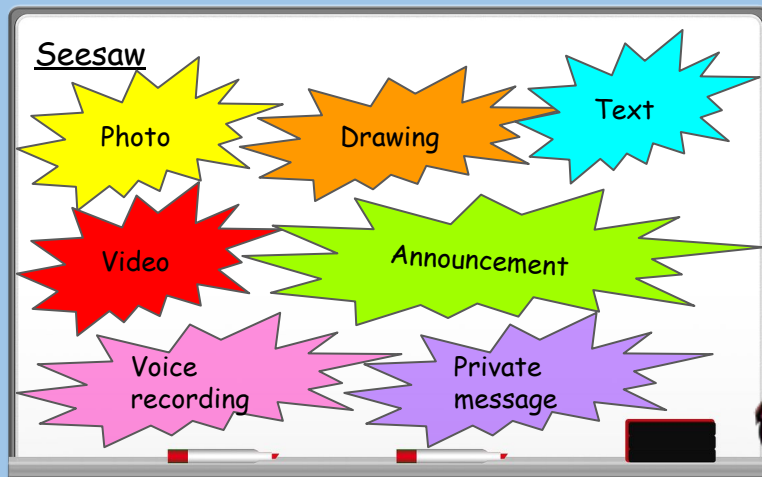


Seesaw

- Compound words;

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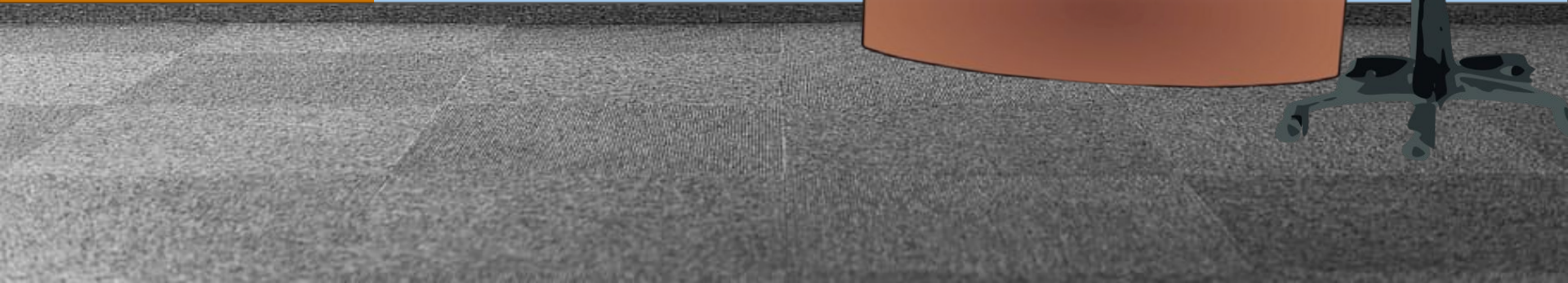

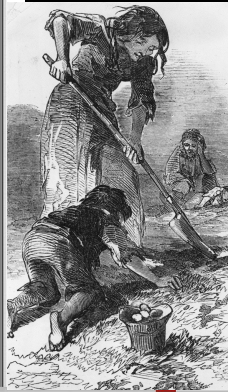

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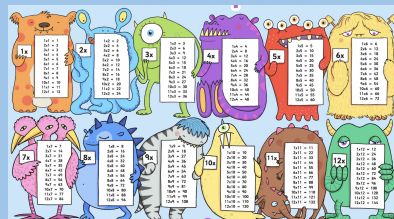

- Support your child's learning and consolidate all aspects of the curriculum at home.

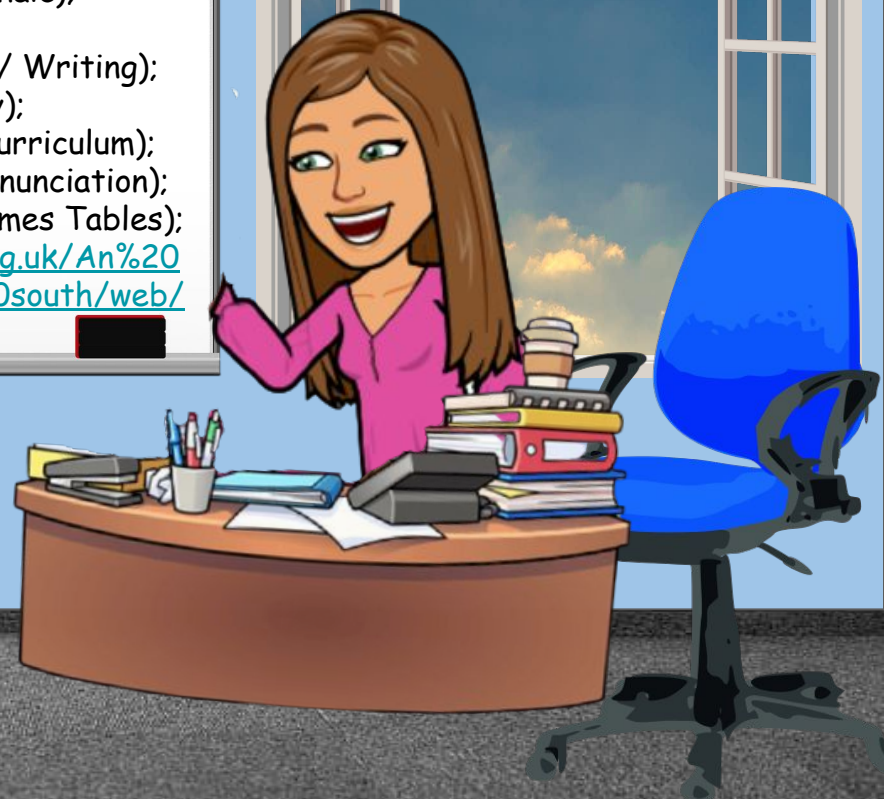
